Women and Children under 6 Income Eligibility Guidelines

# in Household	Max Monthly Income	Allowable Annual Income
1	\$1,670	\$ 20,036
2	\$2,247	\$ 26,955
3	\$2,823	\$ 33,874
For Each Extra Member Add	\$577	\$ 6,919

What is CSFP?: Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) provides food and nutrition education to eligible low-income pregnant women, women 12 months postpartum, breastfeeding mothers, children under six years old and seniors over 60.

Who is Eligible?: Pregnant women, infants and children under 6, senior citizens 60+, women up to 12 months postpartum or breastfeeding.

How to Apply: Eligible applicants can enroll in the program by applying in person at their local distribution site. For the nearest distribution site, please call the food bank at 1-866-350-3663 Ext 13 or 20. Once you are assigned to a distribution site you must provide the following information to determine eligibility:

Women and Children
Photo ID
Proof of Income
Birth Certificate (for children)
Proof of Pregnancy
Proof of Address (i.e. Utility, Water, Phone Bill)

Senior
Photo ID
Proof of Income and or Medical Card
Proof of Address (i.e. Utility, Water, Phone Bill)

* Simultaneous participation in CSFP and WIC is not permitted
